UNDERGROUND PARKING

You can comfortably park your car in our underground parking garage. The barrier can be opened directly at the entrance of the garage or with your chip wristband. The parking lots are free to choose. An elevator takes you directly from the garage up the floors. Please do not park your car in front of the main entrance – due to safety reasons we are entitled to tow any unidentified car.

ELECTRONIC CHIP-WRISTBAND

BATHROBE WALKWAY


Our heated bathrobe walkway means you can access the spa area directly from the hotel.

MASTER SWITCH

Right next to the entrance you can find the master switch, which turns on and off all the electricity in the room. Switched off neither the electrical outlets nor the towel heater will be working.



ELECTRICITY

The voltage in our electrical outlets is 220 volts. The use of razors, hairdryers, electric toothbrushes, mobile phones and notebooks is permitted – any use of other electrical equipment which are not provided by the hotel are not allowed due to safety reasons.

TOWEL HEATER

In your bathroom you can find a towel heater which can be activated by a switch next to it. After activating the switch, the heater will heat up in around 15 minutes and cool down automatically after 45 minutes.



SAFE

The safe is located inside the wardrobe and can be closed and reopened by simply typing in a random 4- digit number and pressing "#"

FLAT PILLOW WITH HORSEHAIR FILLING





Thermal spa dome

Take the plunge and experience total relaxation in 89,6-96,8°F | 32-36°C warm water, flowing from the majestic glaciers down through the mountains to a natural thermal water spring at a depth of 6119,8 ft | 1.865 m.

Sulphur bowl

Kick back and enjoy the scenery as the bubbling water and thermal fountains massage your legs and lower body.

Brine bowl

Warm salt water, light effects and make up for a memorable bathing experience.

Whirl bowl

Sit down on one of the underwater benches and enjoy a whirlpool-style massage with 96,8°F | 36°C warm water streaming out of fine jets.



SAUNA WORLD

Loft sauna (140 °F-195 °F) (60-90°C)

A conventional Finnish sauna with a twist! The Loft Sauna is spread over several levels, meaning guests can choose to sweat it out in temperatures of anywhere between 140°F/60°C and 195°F/90°C depending on where they sit.

Hay barn sauna (160°F/70°C)

Designed in the style of a traditional Alpine barn, this cosy sauna has an air temperature of around 160°F/70°C. We recommend spending 10-20 minutes in the sauna, then cooling off with a stroll in the fresh air and a dip in the outdoor pool before enjoying a warm footbath.

Stone Sauna (175°C-210°C/80-100°C)

Surrounded by earth-toned stone tiles, you can sweat in this Finnish sauna during regular automatic infusions. It smells like orange or eucalyptus, mountain pine or alpine herbs. A stay of about 15 minutes is recommended.

Gogre Sauna (195°F/90°C)

This sauna made of wood, stone and glass appears to be located in the middle of an Alpine canyon. Further decorative elements as well as light and sound effects contribute to a special sauna experience. We recommend 15-20 min. in this sauna.

Herb bath sauna (120°F/50°C)

A relatively mild air temperature of 120°F/50°C combined with music and light effects makes this sauna the ideal place to relax. We recommend a maximum of 20 minutes in this sauna.

Steam dome (115°F/45°C)

The Steam Dome lives up to its grand name as a temple of wellbeing. A pleasant air temperature of around 115°F/45°C and high humidity levels are the ideal way to clear your head, cleanse your pores and rehydrate your skin. We recommend 10-20 minutes, followed by a shower and eventually a quick dip in

the plunge pool.

Brine steam bath (115°F/45°C)

Warm air with a high salt concentration is known to be a great treatment for blocked airways. Our Brine Steam Bath with an air temperature of around 115°F/45°C has its own graduation tower and brine nebuliser to guarantee the ideal climate at all times. We recommend a maximum of 15 minutes.

Waterfall shower

A circular shower tower where guests can choose between torrential tropical rain, a thundering waterfall or fine jungle mist. Give it a go and let yourself be surprised!

Ice grotto

From flaming fire to Arctic ice! The thick layer of ice covering the walls and the ceiling of the Ice Cave immediately neutralises the heat of the sauna – a refreshing and invigorating experience.

Diving pool

Brave souls can take the plunge after a sauna session to kick-start their circulation.

Shower world

Here at the AQUA DOME even the post-sauna shower is an experience to savour. Impressive light effects and cascading water make this a shower cabin like no other!

Quite zones

Take a well-deserved break between sauna sessions and enjoy soothing light and sound effects as you relax on our heated waterbeds and comfy recliners.



SPA 3000

Opening hours:

Dressed area

Herbal tea lounge
(72-75°F/22-24°C)

Enjoy a cup of freshly made herbal tea on our exclusive Herbal Tea Lounge as you gaze out over the village of Längenfeld.

Moss pool
(93°F/34°C)

With a water temperature of 34°C, the Moss Pool is the ideal place to unwind and enjoy a little peace and quiet. There is also a spacious chill-out area with beds and recliners.

Floating relaxation
(72-75°F/22-24°C)

The salt stone walls in this room create a high concentration of salt in the air, which also passes through a dry salt wall on its way into the Salt Room to provide an additional source of ionisation. Specially designed recliners floating a few centimetres above the ground create a peaceful atmosphere.

Herb scrub bath
(108-149°F/42-65°C)

Sign up for a Herb Bath Treatment and let our sauna expert guide you step by step through this soothing process. First you will be asked to select a balm and apply it liberally to your whole body. Herbs will then be added to create a sweet-smelling cream mixture that will soak into the skin during the treatment. Finally, shower off the remaining cream and herbs to reveal sweet-smelling revitalised skin as smooth as silk.

Alpine herb sauna
(140-185°F/60-85°C)

A low-temperature sauna with an invigorating infusion carried out every seven minutes using herbs from the Ötztal Valley.

Mineral shower

Amethyst dust and salt are provided next to the entrance and should be applied to the skin as a first step. Further back there are three showers with

different water temperatures. In each shower the water passes over a specific mineral before reaching the body.

Ötztal mineral bath (104-117°F/40-47°C)

Fine jets spray small quantities of three minerals – selenium, magnesium and lithium – and trace elements into the air to invigorate the body. An information board provides details about the minerals used.

Fireside relaxation area (72-75°F/22-24°C)

A peaceful area with an open log fire and fantastic views of the surrounding mountains.

Längenfeld basins

Four large outdoor bathtubs filled with fresh spring water and covered with a small roof. Designed to be shared by couples.

Cosy lounge (72-75°F/22-24°C)

A raised chill-out area with beautiful interior design and comfy recliners

Mountain fire (195°F/90°C)

This Finnish sauna built around an open fireplace is a great place to enjoy panoramic views of the Ötztal Valley.

Panorama terrace

The outdoor area on the top floor offers fantastic views of the surrounding landscape. Every day at 5.00 p.m. flaming torches are lit on the west-facing terrace overlooking the Hauerkogel mountain, creating a romantic and relaxing atmosphere.

THE HISTORY of the AQUA DOME Tirol Therme Längenfeld

From a simple spring to a state-of-the-art spa

The history of the AQUA DOME actually starts way back in the 15th century. At that time several bathing facilities known as "Bauernbadln" were created in Tyrol, including one in Längenfeld. These baths would be frequented by local farmers wishing to wash, socialise and cool off during the hot summer months.

In 1830, the first scientific tests were carried out on the spring water in Längenfeld by Professor Karpe.

This simple bathing facility at the sulphur-rich spring in Längenfeld remained in place until 1875. An old photo shows a small wooden chapel on a rocky outcrop. Below the chapel there is a spring, while to the left there is a wooden hut built into the mountain. This hut contained the bathing facility and a number of rooms. The water was heated in a cauldron near the spring outside the hut and then carried in buckets by hand to the bathtub inside. These tubs were made of wood and smelt strongly of hydrogen sulphide.

In the early hours of Friday, 5 November 1875 the wooden hut and all of the surrounding buildings were completely destroyed by a fire.

The owner then decided to sell the spring and the land around it to a company from the town of Merano in South Tyrol, which in turn built a simple wooden hut and re-opened the baths.

In 1891, Anton and Peter Gstrein, Johann Tobias Haid, Peter Sigmund Grüner and Josef Falkner purchased the land and spring for 3400 florins.

Just two years later, in 1893, a team of tourism pioneers opened the first modern baths in Längenfeld. The facility was designed by the Berlin architect Walter to look like a typical German Renaissance building, before being adapted to a more traditional Alpine style by local architects. Over the course of the years, it developed into a modern spa hotel.

The busiest period during the year was from June until late September. In 1914 records show 350 guests and around 3000 day visitors.

The hotel closed in 1976 and the building was demolished in 1980. All references to "Längenfeld Spa" were removed from tourism brochures.

The AQUA DOME comes to Längenfeld

In the early 1980s the idea resurfaced of using the local sulphur spring as a spa. The following steps then ultimately led to the creation of the AQUA DOME:

- 1986 Decision to use the spring for a spa facility
- 1990 Drilling tests to a depth of 3084 ft | 940 m
- 1997 Main drilling procedure to a depth of 6119 ft | 1865 m
- 2001 Launch of phase I
- 2002 Start of construction work
- 2004 Official opening of the AQUA DOME on 1st October



The water

Längenfeld's water is a sodium chloride sulphate mixture from a depth of 1865 metres. It has a bivalent sulphur concentration of 5mg S per litre, a natural temperature of around 104 °F | 40° Celsius and a flow rate of approximately 3-4 litres per second.

The spring water is used as fill-up water at the AQUA DOME. Before entering the system, it is treated in order to conform to the provisions contained in the Swimming Pool Hygiene Act and the Drinking Water Ordinance.

THE SURROUNDINGS



Längenfeld

Längenfeld = the long field = 12,43 miles | 20 km long plain, the widest part of the Ötztal.

Much of Längenfeld's special charm comes from the special structure of the landscape and settlement area. The many small hamlets of the municipality lie lined up as if on a string of pearls at the elongated Längenfeld basin. These are Oberlängenfeld, Unterlängenfeld, Astlehn, Ruhnhof, Gottsgut, Huben, Aschbach, Dorf, Espan, Au, Oberried, Lehn, Lehner-Au, Unterried, Winklen and Dorfer Au.

Despite its touristic orientation, Längenfeld is still very rural. Around 200 farms cultivate the unique cultural landscape on and around the Längenfeld valley floor.

A total of 4000 guest beds in all categories are available to international guests.

Altitude: ca. 3937 ft | 1200 m, Area 196 km²

The Ötztal | Summer and winter destination

It is a legend that the Ötz Valley queued twice when the creator strode to distribute the beauty of nature. Otherwise, it cannot be explained that many of the superlatives of the holiday destination Tyrol are concentrated in the valley, which stretches from the upper Inn Valley almost 37 miles | 60 kilometres to the south:

- Highest mountain in Tyrol: The Wildspitze (12382 ft | 3774 m)
- Largest glacier area in the Eastern Alps
- Highest inhabited church village in Austria: Obergurgl (6332 ft | 1930 m)
- Tirol's highest waterfall: the Stuibenfall in Umhausen (492 ft | 150 m)
- Natural jewel Piburgersee in Oetz, one of the warmest bathing lakes in Tyrol
- Approx. 250 three-thousand-metre peaks in the entire Ötztal Alps, 60 of which are over 11155 ft | 3400m high
- Over 808 miles | 1300 km of marked trails
- Highest panorama road in the Eastern Alps, the Timmelsjoch: the about 8 miles | 13 km long glacier panorama road leads up to 9186 ft | 2800 m altitude difference.
- Over 80 huts and alpine pastures, open from the beginning of June to mid-October, some throughout the year
- Over 186,4 miles | 300 km of slopes, more than 70 state-of-the-art lifts

All those who are looking for sporting challenges off the marked hiking trails in summer will declare the Ötztal as the best solution: Canyoning in deep gorges, free climbing on steep walls, rafting in a thundering river or high mountain tours with crampons over the glaciers will give fans from all over the world the last thrill. There are numerous signposted routes for mountain bikers, such as the fa.m.ous Ötztal Trail (approx. 25 miles | 40 km), and even those who are entering new dimensions for the first time on a climbing rope or in a tandem paragliding flight are well advised and looked after here.

Skiing in winter is not everything that Tyrol's largest **winter** valley has to offer its sporty guests. Tobogganing, cross-country skiing, ice skating, curling, carriage rides, snow rafting, snowshoe hiking, ski tours, igloo building, indoor climbing, ice climbing, tandem flights with paragliding enjoy great popularity in the Ötztal and belong to the absolute evergreens for young and old. Most sports equipment can be rented on site. Numerous events and traditional festivals also provide the right holiday atmosphere in the valley of the legendary Ötzi.

Sölden

A hiking area in summer from 1377m to 3774m for hikers and families with children. 300 km of well-marked hiking trails. Alpine pastures and snack stations managed by the locals, 21 mountain lakes, 600 surrounding peaks, 174 of which are over 3,000m high. Tours and hikes to 16 mountain huts and 30 alpine pastures as well as snack stations.

Sölden is also the concentrated power of winter: World Cup venue and one of the most famous ski and snowboard centres in Europe. The generous range of slopes at all levels of difficulty and the excellent preparation of the 147 km of slopes make winter sports a unique pleasure. 73 km of red, 45 km of blue and 23 km of black pistes and 6 km of ski touring routes cover the varied offer, from easy terrain for beginners/light advanced skiers on the Giggijoch to a variety of demanding pistes on the Gaislachkogel ski mountain. The Gaislachkogel (3,058m) is also very popular with all those who want to make their tracks in the snow away from the secured ski area.

The winter ski area is connected to the two glacier ski areas by the Golden Gate to the Glacier lifts, so you can ski directly from the village to the glaciers up to 3250 metres.

With the BIG 3, Sölden is the only ski area in Austria to have 3 three-thousand-metre peaks that are accessible by lifts. The BIG 3 Rally not only takes you to these peaks, but safely through the entire ski area. Sölden also offers a top-class event programme and many events.

Easy walks and hikes in and around Längenfeld

Alluvial paths

Behind the AQUA DOME is the Ötztaler Ache. Here you can walk inwards to Huben, outwards to AU. There are always possibilities to cross the Ache by means of small bridges. In the AQUA DOME hotel lobby, you can enjoy coffee, cake and small dishes afterwards. We also recommend the restaurant Messner-Stuben directly in Längenfeld. You can obtain a map of Längenfeld at the hotel reception.

Our suspension bridge

Have a look at our incredible suspension bridge during breakfast. How do you get there? On foot to Längenfeld Church in the village centre - behind the church up to Brandalm. From the Brandalm to Burgstein (following the marked path) you come to the suspension bridge. From Burgstein it goes directly back to the AQUA DOME. Sigis Jausenstationin Burgstein is recommended for a break.

Walking time: approx. 2. 5 hours.

Alpengasthof a.m. Feuerstein and Legend's way

Take the car to Huben (approx. 5 minutes' drive) and park there at the "zum Feuerstein" car park. Leave your car there and walk uphill for about 1. 5 hours to the Alpengasthof. Along the way you will encounter all kinds of legend figures that reflect the history of the Ötztal Valley. In the evening the path is illuminated. In the Alpengasthof you can enjoy the Tyrolean delicacies.

Gries - Sulztalalm - Amberger Hut

You drive by car to Gries, above Längenfeld (approx. 10 minutes driving time) and park there at the only parking place of the village. From there it goes on sunny ways over the Sulztalalm to the Amberger hut. Refreshments are available in both cabins daily and all day. Walking time from Gries to the Sulztal-Alm: approx. 1 hour, to the Amberger Hut: another hour.

Niederthai – Schweinfurter Hütte

You drive by car out of the valley to Niederthai above Umhausen (approx. 15 minutes driving time). On this sunny high plateau, you can hike to the Schweinfurter Hütte (approx. 2 hours walking time).

Please note that the cabins have different opening hours in summer and winter. We will be happy to provide you with more detailed information at reception.
